


The Treaty Establishing the Energy Community

- Legally binding contract
- Institutional framework ≈ ERI & GRI
- Scope
 - Implementation of the Acquis (non- EU countries)
 - Regional energy market (SEE- the 8th region)
 - Pan- European energy market (EU 27 + WB + MD + UKR)
- Integral part of the EU external policy
 - The Green Paper (2006)
 - Second Strategic Review (2008)

The Energy Community- status quo

- 2nd Package not fully implemented yet, but
 - Amendments underway in BiH, MK, MN, SER
 - MD, UKR- Acquis transposed
- Slow progress in establishing the REM
 - Only one (inter)regional mechanism in place (ITC)
 - Licensing harmonization, CAO, regional market arrangements- under development
- Barriers for establishing the REM
 - High market concentration and vertical foreclosure
 - Absence of market integration
 - Low level of transparency
 - Competencies and coordination of NRA

IMPLEMENTATION OF THE 3RD PACKAGE IN THE ENERGY COMMUNITY

Implementation of the 3rd Package in the EnC Contracting Parties

- The Contracting Parties
 - Fully implement the missing provisions of the 2nd Package
- The EnC Ministerial Council (24th September 2010)
 - Issued a Recommendation on implementation of the Directives 2009/72/EC, 2009/73/EC and Regulations 714/2009 and 715/2009
- The Energy Community Secretariat (2010/2011?)
 - Adapt the 3rd Package under ECT Art. 24 (propose the interface btw. Contracting Parties and EU 27)
- The European Commission (2011?)
 - Propose a Decision for the MC on implementation of the 3rd Package

INVOLVEMENT OF ENERGY COMMUNITY PARTIES IN THE NEW INSTITUTIONAL SET-UP



- Regulations 714/2009 and 715/2009-ENTSO-E, ENTSO-G
 - Adapt the 3rd Package under ECT Art. 24 (propose the interface btw. Contracting Parties and EU 27)
- Regulation 713/2009- ACER
 - Propose a Decision for the MC on implementation of the 3rd
 Package

ENTSO - E

- Members
 - 42 TSOs from 34 countries
- Non-EU countries fully incorporated in the work of ENTSO-E
 - UCTE, ETSO
 - ITC
- Activities
 - Articles of Association (Statute) & Work Program 2009/2010
 - TYNDP (includes non-EU countries)
 - Framework Guidelines- participation in the public discussion (grid connection, transparency, CA & CM...)
 - Network Codes
 - R&D (TSO R&D Plan)
 - Operational issues (common operational tools; cooperation of regions)

ENTSO – E members



ENTSO - G

- Members
 - 32 TSOs from 22 countries (no non-EU members)
- Non-EU not eligible for membership
 - Data collection
- Activities
 - Articles of Association (Statute) & Work Program
 - TYNDP (pilot 2010-2019 finalized; update 2011- 2020 expected)
 - Framework Guidelines- participation in the public discussion
 - Network Codes


ACER

- Members
 - EU NRA
- Non-EU countries participation ?
 - 713/2009 (Article 31)- enables participation of 3rd countries:
 - Concluded agreement with the Community
 - Adopted and applying Community law
 - Financial contributions and staff
- Activities
 - 2011 Work Program
 - Opinion on ENTSO statutes, list of members, RoP
 - TYNDP (national and EU wide)
 - Developing the Framework Guidelines
 - Reviewing the Network Codes
 - Deciding on CA/CM and TPA Exemptions (under certain conditions)
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
To be considered...

- Market integration (ITC, Euro- Pool)
- Massive RES integration in CP& flexibility mechanisms (TYNDP)
- Important E-W and N-S electricity flows in SEE (TYNDP)
- Single regulatory space including existing and planned gas transit routes and storages in CPs

Conclusions

- Factors influencing the EnC CP integration
 - Political factors (SAP, horizontal approach)
 - Energy policy (EU external energy policy)
 - Legal considerations (interface, staff, voting, 3rd package implementation)
 - Functional considerations (ITC, market coupling, TPA exemptions, RES...)
- Leading role of the EC
- Need to avoid divergence btw. EU and CPs
- Change management crucial:
 - National level
 - Regional level
 - Energy Community level
